Re: Request for Financial Records Related to Recent White House Visit

Dear Director Simon:

Pursuant to the Rule 72 of the Standing Rules of the Michigan House of Representatives,¹ American Oversight makes the following request for financial records.

On November 20, 2020, at least two members of the Michigan legislature visited President Donald Trump at the White House. Later that evening, multiple members of the Michigan delegation were seen having drinks at the Trump International Hotel, where they appeared to stay the night.²

Requested Records

American Oversight requests that your office respond to this request promptly and produce copies of the financial records requested below.

1. Records reflecting any and all expenditures of House-affiliated attendees of the Michigan House and Senate Legislative delegation's trip on or about November 20, 2020, to Washington, DC, including, but not limited to, records of any reimbursements submitted by or on behalf of any attendees.

Responsive records would include, but are not limited to, hotel or other lodging invoices or receipts; legislature-issued charge card or travel card reports; receipts from airlines, rental car, or other transportation companies;

records reflecting the cost of government transportation; receipts or other records reflecting the cost of meals or refreshments; or records reflecting per diem payments for each elected official and/or staff member who attended.

2. To the extent not otherwise responsive to item 1 of this request, records reflecting any and all expenditures made at the Trump International Hotel in Washington, DC, including, but not limited to, records of any reimbursements submitted by or on behalf of all House-affiliated attendees of the trip on or about November 20, 2020, to Washington, DC. Responsive records would include, but are not limited to, records reflecting expenditures on hotel lodging, meals, beverages, or other incidental expenses purchased or incurred on the Trump International Hotel premises by any member of the Michigan legislature or staff member who attended the trip.

Please inform American Oversight if you anticipate the fees associated with complying with this request will exceed \$100.

American Oversight recognizes that, because the delegation's trip to Washington, DC, was so recent, the House Business Office may not yet possess all relevant receipts or information. We request that you respond as fully as possible as soon as practicable to this request and update us as you receive new responsive documents going forward.

Conclusion
